This is the second of place believed to be where Jesus was crucified and buried.
























JEWS INTERACT

A famous Rabbi was coming into town and the guys had an amazing evening going through the scriptures with a few Jews.








JEWS INTERACT

The Wilderness and Jericho ruins











Got to preach at many of the same gates the Prophets of old did.










SUNDAY SERVICE
